

# Law No. 21 of 2002 Amending Certain Provisions of Law No. 3 of 1984 Regulating the Sponsoring of the Residence and Exit of Foreigners 21 / 2002

### Articles (1-2)

We, Jassim bin Hamad Al-Thani, Deputy Emir of the State of Qatar,  
Having perused the Amended Provisional Constitution, in particular Articles 22, 23, 34, and 51 thereof,  
Law No. 5 of 1970 determining the powers of ministers and functions of the ministries and other government agencies, as amended,  
Law No. 3 of 1984 concerning the regulation of the sponsorship of the residence and exit of foreigners,  
The proposal of the Minister of Interior,  
The draft law submitted by the Council of Ministers,  
And having taken the opinion of the *Shura* Council,  
Hereby enacting the following law:

## Articles

### Article 1

An addition to the text of Article 9 of Law No. 3 of 1984, referred to above, shall be item 3, to read as follows:

“3. To bear the expenses of processing and burying the deceased sponsored foreigner in a cemetery allocated to him in the State of Qatar, whatever the cause of death, and in the case of a request by one of the legal heirs of the deceased or any other competent entity to transport the body abroad, the sponsor shall bear the transportation costs to the country of origin or permanent residence of the deceased sponsored foreigner.”

### Article 2

All competent authorities, each within its own jurisdiction, shall implement this law, which shall be published in the *Official Gazette*.
