Articles (1-2)

We, Hamad bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar,

Having reviewed the Constitution,

Decree-Law No. 37 of 2002 on the establishment of the Supreme Council of Education (SCE) and determination of its competences, as amended by Law No. 7 of 2004,

The draft law submitted by the Council of Ministers, and

Having taken the opinion of the *Shura* Council,

Articles

Article 1

The text of Article 12 of the aforementioned Decree-Law No. 37 of 2002 shall be replaced by the following text:

Article 12:

"The Council shall have a Secretary General appointed by a resolution of the Council. The Secretary General shall represent the Council before the Judiciary and in its relation with third parties.

The Secretary General, under the Council's supervision, shall discharge all of its financial and administrative affairs in accordance with the bylaws within the limits of the annual budget, in particular the following:

- 1- Supervising the authorities and bodies affiliated to the General Secretariat; coordinating therebetween and assessing their work;
- 2- Proposing the Council's administrative and financial bylaws and the personnel affairs bylaw regulation;
- 3- Implementing the Council's resolutions and follow up the implementation of plans necessary for the achievement of the Council's objectives;
- 4- Preparing the Council's draft annual budget estimate and its closing account;
- 5- Preparing an annual report on the Council's achievements and action programs;
- 6- Any other tasks assigned to him by the Council in accordance with the provisions of this Law."

Article 2

All competent authorities, each within their jurisdiction, shall enforce this Law from the date of its publication in the *Official Gazette*...
