Articles (1-2)

We, Khalifa Bin Hamad Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar;
Having perused the amended Provisional Constitution, in particular Articles 23, 34 and 51 thereof;
Law No. 5 of 1970 determining the powers of the Ministers and assigning the competencies of the Ministries and other government agencies, and amending laws thereof;
Decree-Law No. 16 of 1990 on the compensation of the officers and members of the armed forces and police for their injuries;
The proposal of the Minister of Defence and Interior;
The draft law submitted by the Council of Ministers; and
After consulting the opinion of the Shura Council;
Hereby promulgate the following Law:

Articles

Article 1

The text of Article 8 of Decree-Law No. 16 of 1990, referred to above, shall be replaced with the following text:

Article 8

The right to claim compensation shall prescribe after the lapse of one year from the date of the occurrence during service of the following events:

1. Death.
2. Injury or the emergence of symptoms of illness, without formally notifying the authorities thereof at the time of the occurrence of such injury or illness.
3. A final declaration that a missing person is presumed dead.
4. Notification to the injured person of the Minister's adoption of the report of the medical committee, including the estimate of the proportion of disability or a consideration that the illness is vocational.
5. End of service.

Article 2

All competent authorities, each within their jurisdiction, shall enforce this Law which shall come into force after thirty days from its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
