We, Hamad Bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar;
Having perused the Constitution;
Law No. 13 of 2000 on the regulation of the investment of non-Qatari capital in economic activity, and amending laws thereto;
The proposal of the Minister of Economy and Commerce;
The draft law submitted by the Council of Ministers; and
After consulting the opinion of the *Shura* Council;
Hereby promulgate the following law:

Articles

Article 1

The text of Article 2 (4) of Law No. 13 of 2000 referred to above shall be replaced with the following text:
“2-4. Non-Qatari investors may have a ratio of not more than twenty-five (25) percent of the shares of joint stock companies offered for trading on the Doha Stock Exchange, unless the institutional contract agreement or statute of any of these companies includes ratios in excess of the aforementioned percentage. In the latter case, the ratios specified in the institutional contract agreement or statute shall be approved by a decision of the Council of Ministers on the proposal of the Minister.)

Article 2

All competent authorities, each within their respective jurisdiction, shall enforce this law from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
