

# Law No. 9 of 2010 Amending Certain Provisions of the Military Service Law as Promulgated by Law No. 31 of 2006 9 / 2010

Number of Articles: 2

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Articles (1-2)

We, Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani, Deputy Emir of Qatar,  
Having perused the Constitution;  
The Military Service Law as promulgated by Law No.31 of 2006;  
The Human Resources Management Law No. 8 of 2009;  
The proposal of the Minister of Defence and the Minister of Interior;  
The bill submitted by the Council of Ministers; and  
After consulting the Shura Council;  
Hereby promulgate the following law:

## Articles

### Article 1

The text of Article 3 of the Military Service Law, referred to above, shall be replaced with the following text:

#### **Article 3**

1. Civil servants and workers shall be employed at military entities according to a resolution of the competent authority which shall, subject to the necessary approval, determine their occupational grades, basic salaries, bonuses, allowances and leave according to the provisions of the Human Resources Management Law, referred to herein, and Table No. 1 enclosed therewith.
2. The provisions of Law No. 24 of 2002 on retirement and pensions shall apply to Qataris who are among those civil servants and workers employed at military entities. Such personnel shall be subject to the rules regulating the procedures and penalties relating to military discipline according to the resolutions passed by the competent authority.
3. The relevant authority shall be competent to apply the provisions of the Human Resources Management Law to civil servants and workers employed at military entities in cases not provided for under this Law."

### Article 2

All competent authorities, each within its jurisdiction, shall enforce this Law and it shall be published in the *Official Gazette*
