

Decree-Law No. 17 of 1999 Abolishing the Central Statistics Authority (Repealed) 17 / 1999

Articles (1-5)

We, Hamad Bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar,
Having perused the Amended Provisional Constitution, in particular Articles 23, 27 and 34 thereof;
Decree-Law No. 9 of 1967 promulgating the Law of Civil Service, and the amending laws thereof;
Decree-Law No. 12 of 1980 establishing the Central Statistics Authority, as amended by Law No. 2 of 1994;
Emiri Resolution No. 1 of 1998 establishing the Planning Council;
The Council of Ministers Resolution passed at its first ordinary meeting held on 06 January 1999 approving the abolition of the Central Statistics Authority and devolving its competencies to the General Secretariat for Planning Council; and
The draft Law submitted by the Council of Ministers;
Hereby promulgate the following Law:

Articles

Article 1

The Central Statistics Authority shall be abolished and its competencies, which are stipulated in Decree-Law No. 12 of 1980 referred to above, shall devolve to the General Secretariat for Planning Council.

Article 2

All assets, rights and liabilities of the Central Statistics Authority shall devolve to the Planning Council.

Article 3

The employees of the Central Statistics Authority shall be transferred to the General Secretariat for Planning Council from the effective date of the provisions of this Law, with their same grades and financial status at the time of transfer.

Article 4

Without prejudice to the provisions of this Law, the provisions of Decree-Law No. 12 of 1980, referred to above, shall remain in force. Each provision that violates the provisions of this Law shall be rescinded.

Article 5

All competent authorities, each within its own jurisdiction, shall enforce this Law which shall come into force from the date of its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
