

# Decree-Law No. 23 of 2002 Abolishing Qatar Technical College 23 / 2002

Number of Articles: 6

## Table of Content

Articles (1-6)

We, Jassim Bin Hamad Al-Thani, Deputy Emir of the State of Qatar,

Having perused the Amended Provisional Constitution, in particular Articles 22, 23, 27, 34 and 51 thereof;  
Law No. 2 of 1977 establishing Qatar University and the amending laws thereof;  
Law No. 14 of 1998 establishing Qatar Technical College, as amended by Decree-Law No. 16 of 1999; and  
The draft Law submitted by the Council of Ministers;  
Hereby promulgate the following Law:

## Articles

### Article 1

Acceptance of new students at the Qatar Technical College shall be stopped as of the academic year 2002/2003.

---

### Article 2

1. The College shall continue to conduct its work until graduation of the students enrolled therein, for a period not exceeding three years effective from the date of this Law. This period may be extended by a resolution of the Emir for a maximum period of one year.
  2. The College shall be abolished and its movable and immovable funds shall be devolved to the State at the end of the period referred to above.

### Article 3

A special committee and its formation and remuneration shall be determined by a resolution of the Emir. It shall be responsible for the management of the College and shall implement the procedures necessary for its liquidation until its complete abolition.

### Article 4

The Qatari faculty members and staff of the College shall be transferred to Qatar University with their same functional status and financial grades at the time of transfer. The Ministry of Civil Service Affairs and Housing shall settle the status of those who are not transferred.

---

Article 5

The provisions of Law No. 14 of 1998, referred to above, and its implementing decisions shall be in force without contradicting the provisions of this Law until the end of the period stipulated in Article 2 thereof.

---

Article 6

All competent authorities, each within its own jurisdiction, shall enforce this Law which shall be published in the *Official Gazette*.
