Articles (1-3)

We, Hamad Bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar;
Having perused the amended Provisional Constitution, in particular Articles 23, 34 and 51 thereof;
Law No. 3 of 1983 regulating the Pharmaceutical Profession and the Work of Intermediaries and Agents of
Pharmaceutical Factories and Companies
, and amending laws thereto;
The proposal of the Ministry of Public Health;
The draft law submitted by the Council of Ministers; and
After consulting the opinion of the Shura Council;
Hereby promulgate the following Law:

Articles

Article 1

The texts of Articles 23, 37 and 38 of Law No. 3 of 1983 referred to above shall be replaced with the following texts:

“Article 23

The pharmacy premises must be deemed fit for its purpose.

Article 37

Provisions applied to public pharmacies shall apply to private pharmacies.

Article 38

“A drugstore may only be opened after obtaining a licence from the competent authority in the Council according to the provisions of Article 9 of this law”.

Article 2

Article 10 (2) (4) of Law No. 3 of 1983 referred to above, and any provision that violates the provisions of this Law, shall be rescinded.

Article 3

All competent authorities, each in their respective jurisdiction, shall enforce this law from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
