

# Law No. 9 of 1999 on Allowing the Citizens of the States of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf (GCC) to Exercise Certain Economic Activities in Health Fields in the State of Qatar 9 / 1999

### Articles (1-3)

We, Hamad bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar, having perused the Amended Provisional Constitution, in particular articles 23, 34, 51 thereof, Law No. 11 of 1982 regulating medical establishments, Law No. 2 of 1983 concerning the practice of the professions of human medicine, surgery and dentistry, as amended, Law No. 6 of 1983, initiating the executive steps of the unified economic agreement between the GCC countries, Law No. 6 of 1988 concerning the controls on the practice by the citizens of the Gulf Cooperation Council GCC of economic activities in the State of Qatar, Law No. 7 of 1988 concerning the controls on practice by the citizens of the Gulf Cooperation Council GCC of independent professions (entrepreneurship) in the State of Qatar, Decree-Law No. 25 of 1990 regulating the investment of non-Qatari capital in the economic activity, as amended by Law No. 9 of 1995, Law No. 8 of 1991 regulating the practice of para-medical professions, as amended by Law No. 14 of 1994, Decree-Law No. 10 of 1993 regulating the Ministry of Public Health and defining its functions, The Unified Economic Agreement between the GCC Gulf Arab states signed in Riyadh on 11/11/1981, and ratified on 05.24.1982, The resolutions of the GCC Supreme Council at its eighth session, held in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia in December 1987, and its fifteenth session, held in Manama in Bahrain in December 1994, And the proposal of the Minister of Finance, Economy and Commerce, and the Minister of Public Health, The bill submitted by the Council of Ministers; And after taking the opinion of the Shura Council; Hereby promulgate the following Law:

## Articles

### Article 1

The citizens of the States of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf (GCC) shall be allowed to exercise the following economic activities in the health field, in accordance with the controls stipulated in Law No. 6 of 1988, referred to above:

1. Private hospitals.
2. Private clinics.
3. Treatment of the disabled people.
4. Sports medicine.
5. Psychiatry.
6. Medical laboratories.

### Article 2

Residency in the State of Qatar shall be a condition for natural persons to exercise the activities stipulated in the previous Article.

Article 3

All concerned authorities, each within its competence, shall implement this legislation, which shall come into effect and be published in the *Official Gazette*.
