

Decree-Law No. 12 of 1996 on the Collection of Payment for Textbooks and School Transport Fares from Non-Qatari Students 12 / 1996

Articles (1-8)

We, Hamad Bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar,
Having perused the Amended Provisional Constitution, in particular Articles 23, 27 and 34 thereof;
Law No. 2 of 1962 regulating the public fiscal policy in Qatar;
Law No. 5 of 1970 determining the powers of the Ministers and assigning the competencies of the Ministries and other government bodies, and the amending laws thereof;
Law No. 9 of 1986 implementing certain provisions of the Unified Economic Agreement relating to technical and scientific cooperation between the States of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf (GCC);
The proposal of the Minister of Education; and
The draft Law submitted by the Council of Ministers;
Hereby promulgate the following:

Articles

Article 1

The provisions of this Law shall be applied to non-Qatari students enrolled in all education grades at schools in the State of Qatar. The GCC's citizens shall be excluded from such provisions.

Article 2

Payment for the cost of textbooks and of school transport fares shall be collected from non-Qatari students referred to in the preceding Article.

Article 3

The price of textbooks for all education grades shall be set at one hundred and fifty (150) Riyals for each student for each school year.

Article 4

The fares for school transport for all education grades shall be set at three hundred (300) Riyals for each student for each school year.

Article 5

The fees and amounts stated in this Law may be amended or exempted from payment by a resolution of the Council of Ministers upon the proposal of the Minister of Education.

Article 6

The Minister of Education shall resolve the decisions necessary for the implementation of this Law, including the method for collecting the amounts referred to above and the possibility of payments in instalments.

Article 7

Each provision that violates the provisions of this Law shall be rescinded.

Article 8

All competent authorities, each within their jurisdiction, shall enforce this Law which shall come into force from 01 September 1996 and shall be published in the *Official Gazette*.
