

# Law No. 15 of 2005 amending some provisions of Law No. 1 of 1981 on Regulating Officers' Service in the Armed Forces 15 / 2005

Articles (1-4)

After having perused the Amended Provisional Constitution, and in particular Articles 23, 34 and 51 thereof; Law No. 5 of 1970 specifying the powers of the ministers and establishing the functions of the ministries and other government agencies, as amended; Law No. 1 of 1981 regulating officers' service in the armed forces, as amended; Law No. 5 of 1989 on the State General Budget; Law No. 20 of 2001 regulating military scholarships; The Emiri Order No. 2 of 1977 establishing the Ministry of Defence and appointing a minister; The Emiri Order No. 5 of 1996 concerning the Ministry of Defence; The Emiri Decree No. 11 of 1981 raising the salaries of all civil servants and military personnel in the country; The Emiri Decree No. 8 of 1996 concerning the social allowance for civil servants, as well as housing allowance and domestic help allowance to the military; The Emiri Decree No. 26 of 1996 concerning the housing allowance and domestic help allowance for Qatari military put to the reserve force of the Defence and Interior ministries; The Council of Ministers Resolution No. 1 of 1991 regarding the social allowance and the housing allowance for Qatari civilian and military personnel; The draft law submitted by the Council of Ministers; And having consulted the Shura Council, Hereby promulgate the following law:

## Articles

### Article 1

Articles 9, 10 and 11 of Law No. 1 of 1981 shall be replaced by the following provisions:

#### Article 9

Salaries of the active working officers and those who were put to the reserve force shall be determined according to Table 1 attached to this law, which may be amended by decision of the Emir.

#### Article 10

- a. Officers shall receive an annual allowance according to categories specified in Table 1 attached to this law. The annual allowance shall be earned one year after the date of appointment, and the promotion allowance shall not affect the date of the annual allowance. If both allowances were earned on the same date, they shall be granted.
- b. If the officer reached the maximum point of his rank without being promoted, the Minister of Defence may grant him the annual allowance of the next rank until he receives his promotion.

#### Article 11

- a. Active, working Qatari officers who were put to the reserve force shall be entitled to receive a social allowance specified in table No. 3 attached to this law, which may be amended by decision of the Emir.
- b. The officers of the armed forces shall earn the following allowances and bonuses:
- Transportation Allowance.
  - Nature of work Allowance.
  - Representation at conferences and other functions Allowance.
  - Armed Staff College Allowance.
  - Any other allowances or bonuses determined by the Minister of Defence.
- Executive regulation of this law shall organize the rules, categories and the conditions for granting allowances and bonuses referred to.

### Article 2

Salaries and annual increments for non-commissioned officers and active, working soldiers put to the Armed Forces Reserve Force shall be entitled to receive an annual allowance specified in table No. 2 attached to this law, and they shall be entitled to this allowance according to the rules and regulations applied to officers. The table may be amended by a decision of the Emir.

Qatari non-commissioned officers and active, working soldiers put to the Armed Forces Reserve Force shall be granted a social allowance specified in Table No. 3 attached to this law.

Article 3

The housing allowance, domestic help allowance, livelihood allowance and military allowance for Qatari soldiers shall be cancelled under the legislation referred to, as each provision is contrary to the provisions of this law.

Article 4

All competent authorities, each within its own area, shall implement this law, which shall be effective as of 03.04.2005 and published in the *Official Gazette*.
